Tom Stevenson is the President of Cash Connect, a division of WSFS Bank and has been in the banking industry for more than 30 years. He is a graduate of Wayne State University in Detroit, MI and the University of Michigan Banking and Financial Services Program, Graduate School of Business Administration.

Mr. Stevenson has been involved in mentoring since 1997. In over 15 years of service to the mentoring community, he has mentored countless students. He first started mentoring at Mount Pleasant Elementary, and is currently mentoring at the Delaware School for the Deaf, in a program that he help to found in 2002. He served on the Delaware Mentoring Council Advisory Committee since 2002 and became a member of the Council in 2011. He has been the Chair of the Business Mentoring Alliance since 2005, a subcommittee of the Council. He worked to help found Delaware Youth for Christ, a faith based mentoring program in 2001 and served as their Chair from 2003-2006. In addition to his support for mentoring, he was a founding Board Member of Gateway Charter Lab School and serves on the Community Stakeholders Committee of Sarah Pyle Academy. He supports mentoring throughout the State, and has given presentations to businesses and faith based organizations about becoming involved in mentoring as well as presentations to mentoring groups about ways to get businesses involved in mentoring. This coming year he is working with the DMC to help develop a mentoring program for the Sarah Pyle Internship program, as well as developing seminars for non-profit organizations on Social Media. He is currently the chair of the Board of Directors of Kind to Kids, a non-profit organization that support youth in poverty and foster care. As the President of Cash Connect, a division of WSFS, he encourages all his employees to mentor.
