

**Lifetime Achievement Awardee
Clarice and Dale Wolf - 2006**

Dale E. Wolf is a businessman and politician from Wilmington, Delaware. He is a veteran of World War II and a member of the Republican party, who served as Lieutenant Governor of Delaware and Governor of Delaware.

Before his role in politics, he held a position with the agriculture research division of E.I. du Pont de Nemours and Company. He became the Chairman of the Board of DuPont's Pharmaceutical Business and Group Vice President of the Agriculture business. Meanwhile he was at various times Chairman of the National Agriculture Chemical Association (NACA), Chairman of the International Agriculture Chemical Association (GIFAP), and a member of the Board of the Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Association (PMA).

After leaving public office Mr. Wolf went on to serve in many capacities. He is Chairman of Daynel International, a consultant group that assists companies interested in doing business in China; Vice Chairman of the Board and on the Governance Committee of the publicly held (NASDAQ) WSFS Bank in Wilmington, Delaware; and the Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of Emerald BioAgriculture Corporation, an agriculture biotechnology company in Lansing, Michigan. In 1995, Mr. and Mrs. Wolf also lived in Guangzhou, China and set up the China office for the law firm of Mezzullo-McCandlish.

The Wolfs have been very active in their church and their community. In addition to eight years of leadership in government service, Mr. Wolf is on the Advisory committees of Agriculture, and Hotel Management Schools at the University of Delaware. He serves on the Boards of the Red Cross, Girls Inc., Christiana Care Medical Center Board of Trustees and is Chairman of SURJ (Stand Up for what's Right and Just), an organization dedicated to improve the criminal justice system in Delaware.

In addition to being a dedicated mentor for several schools in Connecting Generations' Creative Mentoring program for many years, Mrs. Wolf has spent much of her life giving of herself to a myriad of good causes including Girls' Club and Sojourner's Place. She is also a very active member of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church in Wilmington.

Together, Mr. and Mrs. Wolf were honored with the seventh Connecting Generations Lifetime Achievement Award.
