Cape Region schools receive mentoring program funds

The Creative Mentoring program has announced that 21 schools will receive funds for their school-based mentoring programs. In the Cape Region, schools receiving funding include East Millsboro Elementary and Long Neck Elementary schools in Millsboro and Rehoboth Elementary School in Rehoboth Beach.

Each of the schools can use the funds to provide materials, supplies or events that will directly impact the students participating in the Creative Mentoring program.

The funds for the minigrants were received from the 2007 Valero Texas Open Benefit for Children's Charity Golf Classic and donated to Connecting Generations, the nonprofit organization that is home to the Creative Mentoring program.

More volunteers are still needed to serve as mentors throughout the state of Delaware, including local school districts. Mentors spend one hour a week in a mentoring program near where they live or work.
